

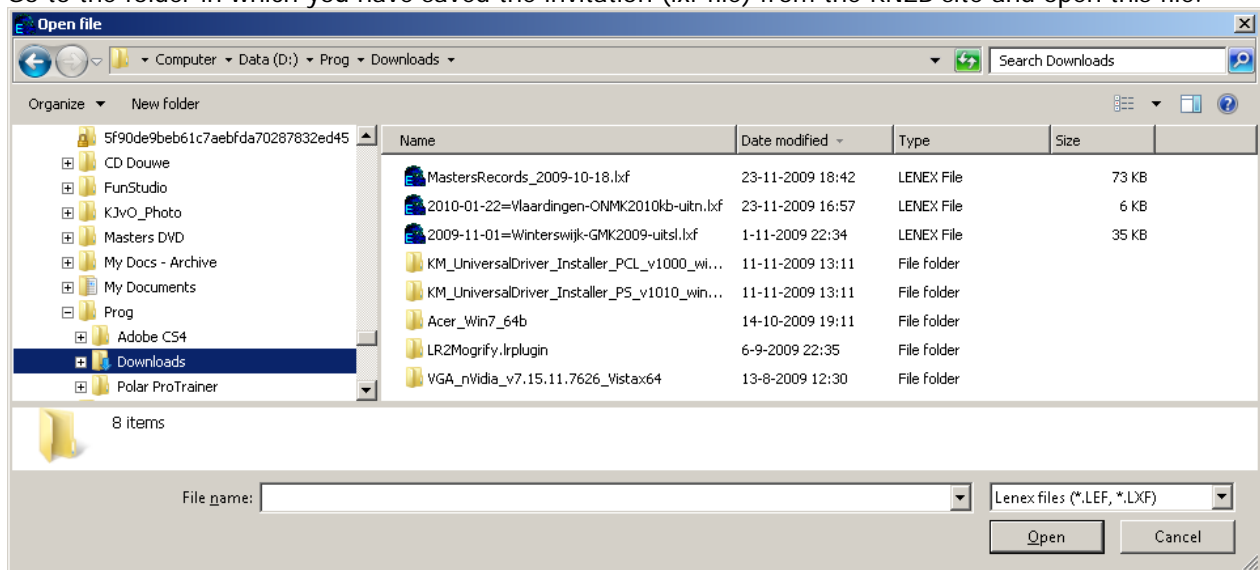


Instructions for entries with Splash Entry Editor for Dutch swimming championships

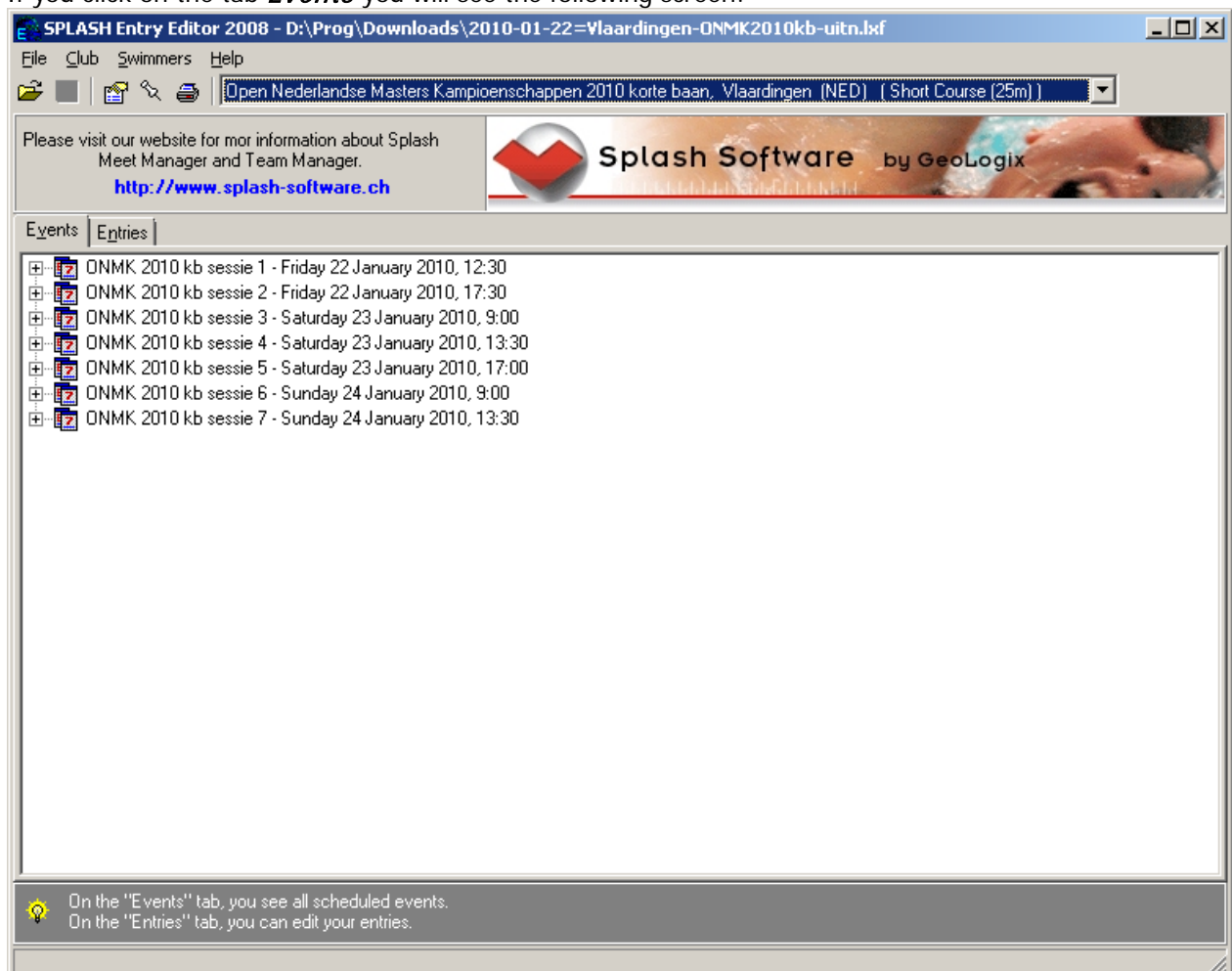


Download Splash Entry Editor (www.Mastersprint.nl/download/1343_2009-01-12_install_eeeditor.zip) and install the software on your computer. Go to **File/Select language** and select your language of choice. Then download the invitation (lxf file) from the KNZB site (http://www.knzb.nl/english/open_dutch_masters_championships_long_course)

Upload the file to Entry Editor: **File/Open**, you will now see the screen in which you can open a file. Go to the folder in which you have saved the invitation (lxf file) from the KNZB site and open this file.



If you click on the tab **Events** you will see the following screen:





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Here you can see all sessions and events that will be swum during these championships. Click on the tab *Entries*, then go to the menu and click on *Club/New*. You will then see the following screen:

Enter all of your club's data and click *OK*.

Then go to *Swimmers/New*. You will get the following screen:

In this screen you should enter the data of the swimmer you wish to enter. Repeat this procedure for all swimmers who should be entered.

Select the swimmer for whom you want to make an entry and go to *Swimmers/Entries* and you will see the following screen:

You can see all events your swimmer could participate in, provided that the swimmer meets the criteria as stated in the conditions that can be found on the KNZB site:

Enter the necessary data for the events your swimmer should be entered in and click on *Save*. Repeat this procedure for all swimmers you are entering.

If you also wish to enter a relay, you should proceed as follows:

Click on *Edit relays* at the bottom of the tab page *Entries* and you will get the following screen:



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Enter the data into this screen and click the button with the four heads  (*define relay swimmers*). You will then get the following screen:

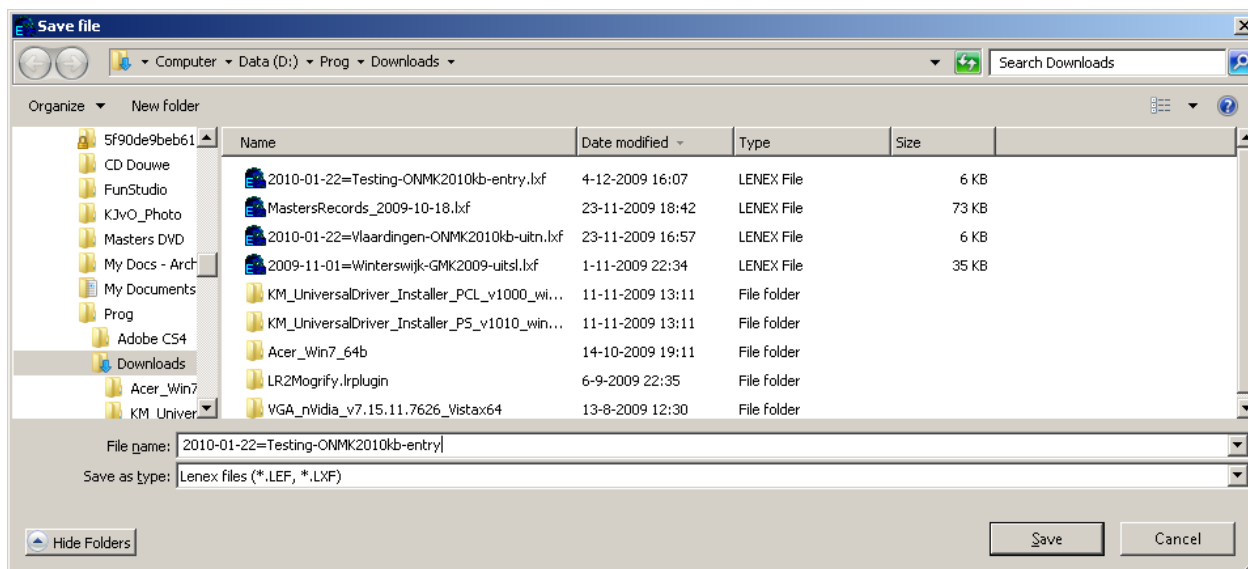


By clicking the green arrows you will be able to select swimmers for the relay.

Once you have made all your entries, you can continue on to creating the entry files that should be sent to the entry address. This concerns 3 files: an lxf file, a pdf file and the entry form (excel or word file depending on the kind of champ.).

First you must create the lenex file.

Go to **File/Save**. You will see the following screen:



Save the file in the following name format:

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012lc-entry.lxf

If you would like to make changes to your entry, you can open this file with Splash Entry Editor.

Then you must create the pdf file.

Go to **File/print entries**. You will get the following screen:

Print entries

Printer name: Adobe PDF

Take care that you have checked the box behind **print date** etc and that behind **group by** you will see **Clubs / Swimmers**.

Click on **PDF** and save the file in the following name format:

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012lc-entry.pdf

Next you should fill in the record form if necessary that you have to download from the KNZB site (http://www.knzb.nl/english/open_dutch_masters_championships_long_course) and save this in the file name format:

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012sc-recordform.doc

All files you have created:

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012lc-entry.lxf

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012lc-entry.pdf

2012-05-04=(Your Swim Club name)-ODMC2012lc-recordform.doc (if necessary)
